Music Scholarship Registration Forms are to be hand delivered to the High School Admissions Office no later than MONDAY 13 FEBRUARY 16h00 along with a certified copy of the Learners Grade 6 End of Year Report, recent and relevant Music Report/s, Certificates and/or a testimonial letter from their Music Teacher/s.

LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

Please note that submitting a Scholarship Application form <u>does not</u> guarantee entry into SACS High School. It also does not commit the candidate to accept a place at the school, should one be offered. The successful music scholarship recipient will be required to take Music as a Subject from Grade 8-12 and be an active member in at least two instrumental music ensembles at SACS. The scholarship will be withdrawn and reallocation if the learner does not continue with Subject Music to Grade 12.

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

It would be advantageous if the learner has achieved a Grade 3 level of performance or above. This may equate to a Trinity College London, Royal Schools (ABRSM), Unisa Certificate. If the learner is currently performing the syllabus of Grade 3 level or above but has not completed the board exam, a letter from his music teacher stating his current performance level will suffice.

Auditions will be held on **THURSDAY 16 FEBRUARY 2023** from **14h00** at the School. Learners will be required to complete a music theory exam and then perform 2 pieces and two scales of his own choice for the auditioning panel. The learner is most welcome to play more than one instrument; i.e., one instrument per piece. Please arrive at the School's Main Reception.

Learners must provide the following:

- Own pen, pencil and eraser to write the exam
- Copies of their two music pieces for our auditioning panel
- Bring their own accompanist should this be required
- Bring their own instruments, if applicable
