ACADEMIC AWARDS

Academic lapel badges are awarded to grade 8 & 9 students who receive 80% and above in BOTH the June and November exams.

Academic Half Blues are awarded to:

Grade 10 students who achieve 80% - 84.9% in BOTH the June and November exams.

Grade 11 students who achieve 75% - 79.9% in BOTH the June and November exams.

Grade 12 students who achieve 75% - 79.9% in the September Trial exams.

Academic Full Blues are awarded to:

Grade 10 students who achieve 85% and above in BOTH the June and November exams.

Grade 11 students who achieve 80% and above in BOTH the June and November exams.

Grade 12 students who achieve 80% and above in the September Trial exams.

General merits are awarded at prize-giving as follows:

Grade 8 – 11 students who achieve a combined average of 80% and above for the June and September exams using the formula: $(2x \text{ June} + \text{Sep})/3$.

Grade 12 students who achieve a combined average of 80% and above for the June and September exams using the formula: $(\text{June} + \text{Sep})/2$.

Subject prizes are awarded at prize-giving to the **top** achiever in each subject using the same formula as for General Merits.
